This event is open to anyone who wishes to attend. Bring along family members and friends for this special occasion.

Besides the “behind the scenes” tour you can also tour the Main Museum to look at all the displays including the 4 “Featured Exhibits” that will end in April. These are currently Forgotten Features showcasing odd and unique factory original options that are no longer produced, Broncos: Past & Present with a classic model aside a brand new Bronco, Get your Husky On presenting street & dirt models of Husqvarna motorcycles, and of course the Shelby Showroom with three GT-350's and plenty of memorabilia and articles on display.

Of course there are still plenty of automobiles, motorcycles, buses and miniatures to view and the museum is now home to the amazing Tucker Automobile Preservation Society as well. With only 51 Tuckers ever built, the Museum has 3 on display!! There is also Tucker engines, suspension components, a complete chassis, and many other Factory blueprints and prototype parts displayed. Glen is also knowledgeable on Tucker automobiles as well.
